On Good Friday, we venerate the Cross. This year, as you do so, why not commit your cause to the Lord. This could be a burden you are carrying, a particular intention that you are praying about, or a grace you wish to receive. Simply offer it at the foot of the Cross for the Lord to deal with. Be

confident. because the Resurrection victory has already been won.
